Texas State Wind Symphony chimes in for Friday concert

Texas State University's Wind Symphony Orchestra will perform works by Copland, Mozart and Bach during its concert at 7:30 and 9:30 p.m. Friday in Evans Auditorium.

Dr. Caroline Beatty, who will direct the Texas State Wind Symphony, says the concert will offer an interesting mix of music and musical instruments. One particular piece presented is "Bells for Stokowski" by Michael Daugherty.

"This composition has everything from chimes wailing on both sides of the band, to an organ, to an electric guitar playing within the ensemble," Dr. Beatty said. "The audience will hear everything from a fugue, similar to the Bach, to a funky groove with the brass playing hits like a big band all leading to a rousing finish."

The concert also will showcase students from the School of Dance with the School of Music, featuring works by Scott McAllister and Shafer Mahoney.

Tickets for general admission will cost \$5 and \$3 for seniors and students. Tickets will be sold at the door 30 minutes before the show.
